## MT WASHINGTON

As is the case with the BAA Marathon, the Club also gets a number of entrees to the MT WASHINGTON Race. These entries are given to members who had their entry rejected and who have been active club members. First priority is given to those members that volunteered to work at the prior year's Mt Washington race. Specific details on obtaining an entry will be made available in subsequent months. Instructions for gaining entry to the June 15, 2002 Mt. Washington Road Race is as follows: The 2002 race will be held as usual on the third Saturday of June, the 15th. Registration may be done either online, or by printing out an online form and mailing it in with your check. You do NOT need to send a Self Addressed Stamped Envelope for information - it will all be provided on the web site. The registration website will be available between 10:00 a.m. on March 1st and will remain open until March 15.

To be able to race you must secure one of the 1100 numbers that will be issued. Most are by random draw. A few are reserved for elite or invited runners, last year's award winners, any former race winners, and those with unbroken streaks since 1984. Multiple entries from the same person will cause rejection.

There will also be a section for groups of up to 5 people to sign up together. These groups will be treated as one lottery draw and will all get in together if accepted. Sorry, but 5 is the maximum this year.
